Subject: Abstract of the presentation of Global Equestrian Technology bv.

News and social media are full of both fear and optimism on how AI will increasingly affect every aspect of our lives. So the relevant question came up: how can we use AI in the equestrian world in order to help the studbooks in their daily operations and to generate data and knowledge we don't have today. Global Equestrian Technology is a start-up company that started from the above awareness. They have used machine learning technologies to build a video analysis system that is capable of registering biomechanical movements of horses and riders and deduct all kinds of observables out of this huge mass of numbers. Before this system is explained and shown, a short introduction on AI is given. What is it and how does it work. What are the limitations of AI at the moment, what is needed for further development. What kind of solutions can we expect from it.

Topics in this area are:

- ✓ Can Al assist there with predictive models based on sport results and linear profiling data that are available?
- ✓ What if images have been photoshopped, how is fraud combated?
- ✓ What about AI for the analysis of documents used in studbook administrations

It will be clear that the possibilities of AI almost endless, but nothing will come by itself. On the other hand, also the equestrian world will have to accept and use it. It's not a matter of whether it will come or not. The question is when and by whom it will be controlled.
